



## City of Worcester Gymnastics Club Fees and Charges Policy

### Purpose

This policy provides clarity on how membership fees are calculated and applied across all programs at City of Worcester Gymnastics Club. As a registered charity, all income is reinvested into the club to support our mission of providing high-quality gymnastics opportunities for the community.

### General Principles

- Fees are set annually and reviewed each November in line with the government's advice on the minimum wage and the national living wage
- Increases are kept as modest as possible and are typically linked to inflation and rising operational costs.
- All fees are published on the club website and communicated to members before the start of each membership year.
- This policy should be read in conjunction with the club's Refund and Cancellation Policy, which sets out how refunds are managed.

### Recreational

- Fees are calculated based on the number of weeks per year that classes are offered and split into 10 week terms throughout the year.
- The club only closes for two weeks at Christmas.
- Missed sessions due to personal reasons (e.g., illness, holidays, other commitments) are not refundable.



### **Squad and Advanced Recreational Fees**

- Squad and Advanced Recreational fees are calculated on a monthly basis and payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month via Direct debit which is set up through JustGo and your child's BG membership portal online.
- As training hours increase, the hourly fee decreases, reflecting the club's charitable commitment to supporting higher-level training.

### **Support & Concessions**

- As a charity, City of Worcester Gymnastics Club offers 5% discount for a first sibling and 10% for a second sibling. We also offer a 5% discount for a second recreational session if they wish to do two.
